Behavior Reports

- 1. ADT will complete a Behavior Report whenever appropriate.
- 2. A Behavior Report is a tool used to improve your child's experience with ADT.
- 3. When undesirable and concerning behavior challenges take place, we document and counsel the student.
- 4. Parents/guardians are always informed and will sign off on the document at dismissal.
- 5. These reports will be kept along with student records and are available for review upon request.
- 6. We refer students to our community partners after three (3) Behavior Reports.
